### Details of research projects

1. A project was carried out on the topic 'Education among Pawaras' in 1981. Pawara is a Scheduled tribe in Dhle District, Education among this tribe particularly with reference to Primary Education has been highlighted. Illiteracy, traditional beliefs, regarding gods and goddesses, certain taboos and moreover, poverty is the causes for poor attention to education.
2. The second project was completed in 1982. The topic entitled "Educational Profile of a Caste Village" (A study of Impact of Education in Uprai) M.P. Uprai is a multicasite village in Datia District, M.P. In Uprai there was a School upto higher Secondary. However, the percentage of girls were very low as compared to boys. Educational Condition had been deteriorated because of (i) Caste spirit (ii) Political Situation (iii) and impact of dacoits on daily life.
3. Another project was undertaken in Swastic Rubber Industry in 1986 for "Safety measures & accident". In most of the rubber company though there are various provision for safety but accident took place, thus Swastik Rubber can not escape from that. It seems that percentage is too low but provision can be made to reduce it. It also reveals that safety provision given are quite optimum and also the workers are aware the facts and thus working with much safety.

Above statement is for all workers but very some workers get involved in the accident because of carelessness and not following rules and regulation.

Spreading section is the major section where maximum accident took place.

In majority of the cases, workers hand or some times only fingers and foot get involved in the accident because either hands in the rolls of mills or mould falls on the feet.

It has also been observed that, workers those are not acquainted with handling the machine or temporary workers or unskilled workers are the cause for accident

4. In 1994, a project work was completed on "Ghasia : Metal Casters of Central India" this project was sponsored by Franco – Indian Research Pvt. Ltd., Project for Indian cultural studies, Bombay.

Ghasia, a low Dravidian Caste of Orisa and central Indian who cut grass, tend horses and act as village musicians at festivals. In Bastar they are described as an inferior caste who were as horse-keepers and also make and mend brass vessels. AnthroPolocical and Sociological data had been collected on various aspects like historical and traditional background, population, occupation, habitat, dress pattern, life cycle, dialect, marriage rules and inter-ethnic relationship.

5. A project had completed on "Evaluation of resource persons at Academic Staff College, University of Pune", Pune, in 1997. The main purpose of this project was to study resource persons in view of identification, evaluation, effectiveness and

usefulness of the topic and programme. The data has been collected from the participants who have attended the orientation programme during the period of 1995-96.
